Councillor Doucette would like to let you know that we have been made aware of a coyote being sighted in your neighbourhood. It was spotted yesterday in a couple of different locations including Humberside Collegiate grounds, Clendenan Ave, on Medland near Annette also at Aziel and Humberside Ave.

The City of Toronto [website](#) has some extremely useful information about coyotes and we recommend you take a look to learn more. As this site reminds us:

Many wild animals, including coyotes, have adapted well to life in the city. Because food and shelter are plentiful, and natural predators are limited, these animals will continue to live near us. If we learn to share the environment with wildlife and reduce problems by getting rid of sources of food and shelter on our properties, we can be entertained by these visitors as they make their way to a more suitable home.

If a member of your school community spots a coyote please follow the recommended safety tips and consider reporting it through the website so Animal Services can keep a record of the animal sightings.
