## PROBLEMS

- Disobeying No Parking/No Stopping/No Standing signs
- Opening car doors into traffic

- Disobeying School Crossing Guards
- Parking near crosswalks and corners

## DEFINITIONS

### PARKING

The standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when standing for the purpose of, and while actually engaged in, the loading or unloading of passengers.

### STANDING

The halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except for the purpose of, and while actually engaged in, receiving or discharging passengers.

### STOPPING

The halting of a vehicle, even momentarily, whether occupied or not, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with the directions of a constable or other police officer, or of a traffic control sign or signal.
